





### 1.Introducere

To comply with the article's form rules, please read carefully the following:

The article will have a minimum of 4 pages and a maximum of 8 pages - arranged in two columns. Prefer a PAR number of pages! We recommend the use of Office 2013. It is mandatory to complete the sections of Abstract, keywords and content - in English!

It is mandatory for the article to have an Introduction section and a Conclusion section, or it will be rejected. Articles that do not have at least 3 chapters / subchapters / sections are rejected.

It does not matter the function or the teaching degree of the person who wrote the article. The only necessary information is the name, surname, title of doctor, if applicable, the institution to which it belongs, the country of origin (possibly the department) and the email address. o footnotes are inserted. Indication of references is made using the source number, in brackets, in the form [1], and the corresponding note is added at the end of the document, in the References section. Also here, in the same form, the other bibliographic sources are added, even if they do not have a direct correspondent in the text [2].
